

## SIATech/CNM Dual Enrollment Program

### *Frequently Asked Questions*



#### What is dual enrollment?

SIATech has an agreement with CNM that allows our students to attend CNM classes for free. If you qualify for this program, you can be “dual enrolled”, and take high school courses at SIATech and college courses at CNM at the same time.

#### What kinds of classes are available at CNM?

CNM offers academic classes, like English, Math, and History, art classes, like Drawing and Computer Graphics, and vocational classes, like Culinary Arts, Cosmetology, and Carpentry. For details about the programs of study available to you, visit <http://www.cnm.edu/studies/proglist.php>

#### What kind of credit do I receive for completing classes at CNM?

- Your courses at CNM can count as credit toward your diploma at SIATech, depending on the courses you take.
- You also receive college credit toward an Associate’s Degree (2-year degree) or a vocational Certification Program for completing courses at CNM.
- Most academic courses at CNM also transfer as credits toward a Baccalaureate Degree (aka Bachelor’s Degree, or 4-year degree) at UNM.

#### How do I qualify for the SIATech/CNM Dual Enrollment program?

- The most important qualification for SIATech/CNM dual enrollment is recommendation from your SIATech teachers (see application packet).
- Your attendance and effort in SIATech classes must be exceptional.
- Your reading and mathematics skills must be strong.

#### Where can I find the application packet?

- R drive > Dual Enrollment > SIATech CNM Dual Enrollment Application
- Type in the information in the first two pages, save it to your documents, and print the form.
- After the first two pages are complete, hand them in to Ms. Roth.
- Give each recommendation form to a teacher who is willing to recommend you. The teachers will fill out the forms and give them to Ms. Roth.
- When all sections of your application are complete, a committee will review your application and you will be informed of the results of the review.

*If you are accepted into the program, you will then need to take the **Accuplacer**, which is a test that CNM uses to determine the level of coursework you are capable of doing. You must place into 1000 level classes on your Accuplacer to be eligible for dual enrollment.*
